# **COWBOY / 500-YARD RANGE ACTIVATION PLAN**

### 1. COWBOY/500-YARD RANGE GATE:

(a) Gate will normally be positioned for active 500-yard Range and locked.

(b) Gate will be positioned for active Cowboy Range during scheduled Cowboy Range activities or range maintenance and locked.

(c) Gate will be fastened and locked, blocking shooting positions at 500-yard Range when Cowboy Range is active.

#### 2. ACCESS GATE LOCKING:

- (a) Gate will be locked in proper position at all times.
- (b) Only restricted non-duplicatable key locks will be used.
- (c) Three (3) keys will be issued.

#### 3. RESPONSIBLE PARTIES:

- (a) Outdoor Range Officer;
- (b) Deputy Outdoor Range Officer; and
- (c) Officiating Cowboy Action Range Officer.
- (d) Each party will hold one (1) key.

## 4. OPERATIONS:

- (a) Gate position can only be changed when all responsible parties present are in agreement that both ranges are safe.
- (b) The responsible parties must verify that no persons are at the active range BEFORE changing gate position.

#### 5. SIGNS:

- (a) Access Gate
  - (i) 500-yard Range Closed Cowboy Range Active
  - (ii) Cowboy Range Closed 500-yard Range Active
  - (iii) Shoot only at gongs
- (b) Sign on Blocking Cable
  - (i) Danger Range Closed Persons Down Range
