

## COWBOY / 500-YARD RANGE ACTIVATION PLAN

### 1. COWBOY/500-YARD RANGE GATE:

- (a) Gate will normally be positioned for active 500-yard Range and locked.
- (b) Gate will be positioned for active Cowboy Range during scheduled Cowboy Range activities or range maintenance and locked.
- (c) Gate will be fastened and locked, blocking shooting positions at 500-yard Range when Cowboy Range is active.

### 2. ACCESS GATE LOCKING:

- (a) Gate will be locked in proper position at all times.
- (b) Only restricted non-duplicatable key locks will be used.
- (c) Three (3) keys will be issued.

### 3. RESPONSIBLE PARTIES:

- (a) Outdoor Range Officer;
- (b) Deputy Outdoor Range Officer; and
- (c) Officiating Cowboy Action Range Officer.
- (d) Each party will hold one (1) key.

### 4. OPERATIONS:

- (a) Gate position can only be changed when all responsible parties present are in agreement that both ranges are safe.
- (b) The responsible parties must verify that no persons are at the active range BEFORE changing gate position.

### 5. SIGNS:

- (a) Access Gate
  - (i) 500-yard Range Closed – Cowboy Range Active
  - (ii) Cowboy Range Closed – 500-yard Range Active
  - (iii) Shoot only at gongs
- (b) Sign on Blocking Cable
  - (i) Danger – Range Closed – Persons Down Range
