ELECTRONIC GATE FAQ

The new electronic gate has gone live and aside from working out small kinks in the system, is working as intended. In an attempt to get ahead of any confusion or possible issues caused by user error we offer the following simple step-by-step guide for operation of the electronic gate and proper use of your access cards. Please, remember that this system has been put in place to make the outdoor range a safer place for the members, and not with any intention of making things difficult for anyone.

Entering the Range: Upon arrival at the outdoor range, stop and scan your card at the reader even if the gate is currently locked in the open position. Make certain that when you scan the card you get a green light, and the readout indicates "Access Granted".

Exiting the Range: Scan your card at the exit reader, wait for the gate to open, then drive out. DO NOT follow another member out without scanning your card.

FAQ:

Why do I need to scan my card when the gate is already open?

The system is set to track each card when it enters or exits the range and save that information. A card is identified as either logged into the system (Entered the range) or logged out of the system (Exited the range) and will not allow a duplicate entry which will prevent your card from working the next time used. What that means electronically is that if you have either gone into or exited the range without swiping your card your personal ID number will remain in the last scanned state in the system.

I scanned my card to enter the range and it displayed the message "Passback Violation" and won't work.

As previously said, the system is tracking the status of your card. This message is displayed when you are trying to scan into the system a second time, meaning the last time you left the range you did not scan your card out.

I made a mistake, and didn't scan my card to get into the range, or it's after open hours on the range, and I'm locked in.

You will need to contact one of the executive members of the club with the contact information provided in the Crack Shot.

I am bringing some guests to the range to shoot, and we are bringing multiple vehicles, how can we get in and out without the gate closing on us or getting someone locked in?

Make sure that all vehicles are lined up and ready to go, there is a sensor on the gate itself that triggers the countdown timer for the gate to close. Any time that it is triggered it will reset the closing timer. After the gate opens there is a generous window of time for each vehicle to make it through before the gate will begin to close.

We are leaving the range, but the gate is just sitting open.

The gate has a roughly 40 second timer before it starts to close after a vehicle has passed through the gate. It can feel like forever, but it will close on its own. Do not go back and scan your card repeatedly, that will just reset the timer over and over, as well as put your card into a logged in state, keeping it from working the next time you come to enjoy the range.

Make note of the installed orange safety line at the <u>300-yard range and the intermediate Cowboy range</u>. **Do not shoot this orange line or anything above it.** Keep all bullets well below the range area.

Reminders:

- Members must be present if their key is used at the outdoor range, with the exception of Associate Members. Be prepared to show your 4CRP Membership card upon request.
- There are extra trash bags in the Target Shed; if the trash is full, please take it to the dumpster. Little things like this will help keep the Outdoor Range tidy and clean so all of us can enjoy it.
 - Shooters in the field need to be aware of their target and what is behind that target, i.e., can the bullet potentially ricochet into one of the other ranges or over the berm? You are responsible for the bullet once it leaves the muzzle of your gun until it stops. This includes ricochets!
 - Please, be aware of the cylinder and muzzle blasts on the sandbags which can cause holes to be burnt in the denim covering.

HUNTER SAFETY SUPPORT FROM THE FOUR CORNERS RIFLE AND PISTOL CLUB

Each year Four Corners Rifle and Pistol Club host a HUNTER SIGHT-IN to help individuals have safer hunting equipment and experiences. The Club's Outdoor Range is closed to members for two days before the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd rifle seasons to concentrate on safe shooting practices and equipment repairs as needed. Club volunteers assist the hunters with sighting in their rifles before they head up into the woods for their elk, deer, or bear hunting seasons. For only \$10.00 per firearm, they provide targets, shooting benches, high-end spotting scopes, and a personal Range Safety Officer to help sight in the shots.

The 4CRPC 2023 Hunter Sight In went very well, thanks to the fourteen club volunteers who assisted with advice and safety. We had 148 Hunters sighting in 178 rifles for the three rifle seasons. We also had 23 Hunters shooting two shots for \$10 at 10" pumpkins offhand upon the 100 yard berm, with only 6 being able to hit a pumpkin for a free 4CRPC hat. In summary, these events raised \$2010 for the Junior Shooter Program, and was fully appreciated by all the hunters who participated. With out-of-state licenses costing between \$350 and \$650, plus guide fees, motels, and food, these folks and our Club volunteers will show up for "opening morning" no matter the weather.

For those who don't know, it is illegal to shoot within 24 hours of your hunting season once a hunter arrives at their assigned hunting unit. The availability of a range that hunters can go to on the way to their hunting destination is invaluable.

I want to personally thank the 4CRPC Volunteers who showed up assisting with the five dates of Sight In.



ANNUAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ELECTIONS 2018 CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

- e. Immediately following the January Regular meeting, a Mail-In Ballot will be prepared and will be included in the February issue of the *Crack Shot*. This Ballot will list each Club Office position and the name of members who are candidates for each office.

HELP WANTED

All 4CRP Club Executive Committee positions are up for election at the February meeting each year. We hope you will consider volunteering for a position, recommend others who might like to fill the positions, or volunteer to be "assistant" to one of these positions. Brief descriptions of positions we will vote on:

A – Membership Secretary – <u>POSITION OPEN beginning March 2024</u> - voting member of the Executive Committee, this is one of the Club's most important positions. Overall responsibility is to maintain a current list of paid Club members and ensure that each of them have appropriate key-card access to the Outdoor Range.

Specifics activities include: collect and post moneys weekly from RDF Guns and Goods for the Woods (or wherever our Club members can pay for memberships in person); review weekly notifications of online payments made thru the Club website – post; update the key-card reader at the Outdoor Range on a regular, weekly basis; update Communications Director with new or deleted emails; submit funds and balance sheet to Treasurer every 2-4 weeks; hold range safety orientations for new members (or arrange for other Board Members to make the presentations) twice each month; respond promptly to phone or text inquiries about membership status.

Estimate from Jenn McHenry, the current Membership Secretary, is that the average time spent on this position is 4 hours/week, and she has offered to provide extensive training and support to whoever takes this position [©] Heaviest membership months are Feb – April

(Because of all the other responsibilities with this position, they do NOT take notes at our monthly Club meetings.)

Outdoor Range Director – POSITION OPEN beginning March 2024 Monitor all needs for the Outdoor Range and report at the monthly Club meetings. Authorize and schedule range users for special activities – open/close gates for these activities. Schedule 2-3 "Range Cleanup Days" per year, contact the volunteers and direct this activity. On a weekly basis, check on the range – clean as needed, replace overly used target stands or other equipment as needed.

We currently have the other "Board" positions filled, but several of our Executive Committee members would be happy to step down or *accept an assistant* if someone is interested. These are elected positions each year. If interested please call Mike Upchurch 970-508-3268 Brief descriptions of these Executive Committee positions include:

3 Board positions –Must attend most Club monthly meetings – bring your knowledge and expertise to make decisions for Club financial and operations challenges; serve on Budget Committee (approx. 2 hours/year) or other one-time committees as assigned by the President; possibly assist in giving Range Safety Orientations at the Outdoor Range. Help with other activities as available.

President / Vice-President – Someone genuinely interested in the current and future well-being of the Club. These folks have generally spent some time in other volunteer positions with the Club – getting to know the strengths and challenges. Obviously they run our general meetings and are the central "go to" for every challenge or activity. They are co-signors on the Club's checking accounts.

Indoor Range Director – Monitor all needs and activities for the Indoor Range and report at the monthly Club meetings. Schedule 3-4 work days per year as needed to replace cardboard target backings, spray / clear weeds, etc. Clean the range monthly, monitor propane levels, schedule heating/cooling system maintenance, authorize range users for special activities and open/close gates and building for those events.

Treasurer – Takes about 5 hrs/week. In general, responsible for accurately maintaining 4 checking accounts + CD's and Club credit card. Reconcile accounts monthly and create Treasurer's Report for monthly Club meetings. The Treasurer checks the P.O. box 2-3 times/week, gets approval for expenses as needed, writes and distributes checks on a weekly basis; provides financials needed for and leads the Budget Committee and the Audit Committee – a more detailed description available if you'll contact Anita Mayhew 970-903-5120

Junior Shooters Director is retiring after the 2023 season, but has been training several replacements. Assistants welcomed – Very likely the position of Director of Jr Shooters will be shared by two volunteers who are already "in training" ... but assistants are always welcome ! The program is very active and successful – guiding approximately 20 junior shooters each week thru the school year.
